

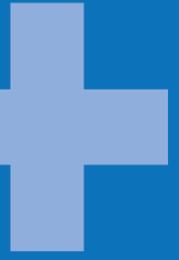

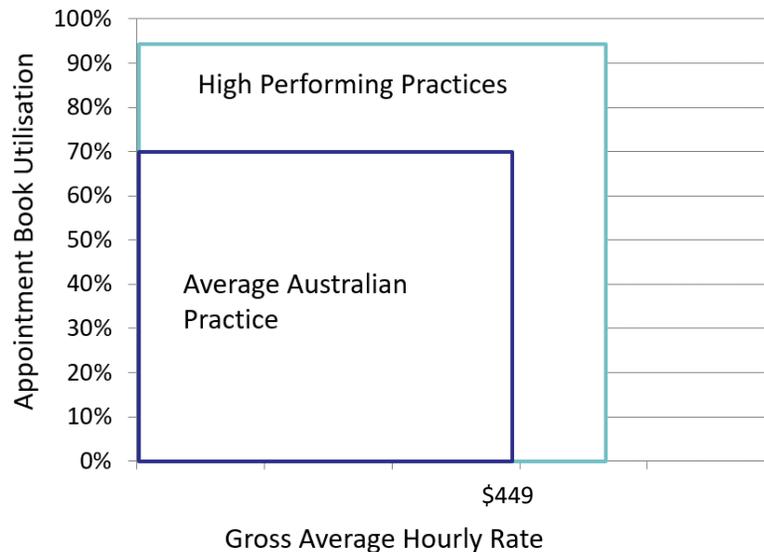

Driving Revenue

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Every dental practice is different. Some are smaller, some larger. Some do cosmetic dentistry, others don't. However, evidence shows that if you are able to understand the key performance indicators within your practice, and work out how to influence them, you can drive your business forward and get closer to achieving your clinical, business and personal goals.

To start, we must firstly understand how your practice is currently performing in the all important area of revenue generation.



Below is the 'Gross Average Hourly Earnings'

Having analysed several hundred practices we know that the average Australian practice has an appointment book utilisation of 73%* (not generating revenue for 27% of the time a practice is open).

We also know that based on the 2018 ADA fee schedule, the average hourly earnings are approximately \$449 per hour for a general dentist and \$632 per hour for a specialist.

The diagram reinforces the idea that if you want to increase the amount of money your business turns over annually you need to:

1. Increase the amount of money you charge per hour and / or
2. Raise the amount of time your chair is utilised.

Utilisation

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The information provided under 'surgery utilisation' relates to how much you occupy your entire facility for the time you are open.

For example: if you have a four chair practice, but only ever utilise two chairs, you are already running at a maximum of 50% capacity. Combine this with short notice cancellations and FTA's and your surgery utilisation can be lower than what you might expect. To add to this, your overheads such as rent and utilities will remain the similar regardless of how much you are utilising your practice.

If you want to improve your surgery utilisation, consider reviewing some of your practice processes such as your recall system. You may find some more ideas over the next few pages of this report.

Recall Effectiveness

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An effective recall process is the lifeblood of every practice, however it does take some thinking about. For example, you wouldn't want to dilute your average hourly earnings by over exaggerating your recall process.

According to Software of Excellence, the Australian average for recall effectiveness is around 58% - this means that out of every 100 recalls that are sent – 42 don't rebook in the month that they are due to come in.

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Patient attraction and retention - It is important to get your mix of active and new patients right.

Active patients provide consistency in both revenue and your appointment book, whilst new patients historically provide greater revenue. Therefore the number of new patients joining the practice on a monthly basis needs to be greater than the number of patients that leave.

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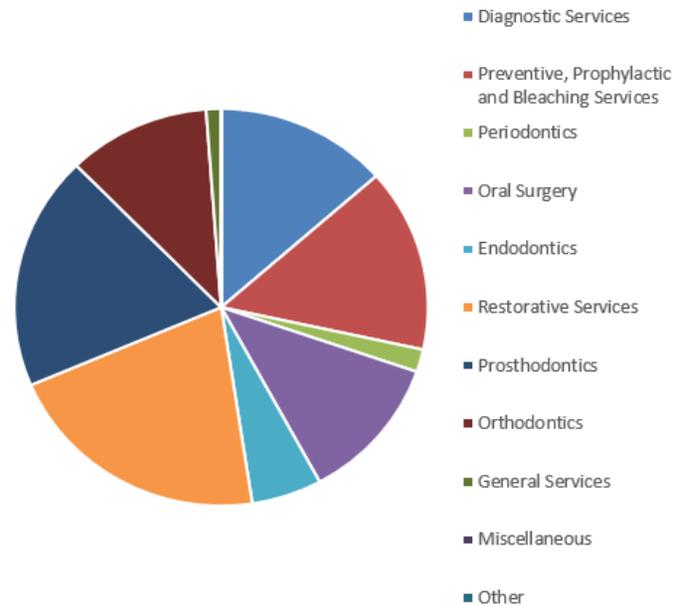
