MASTERING CAD-CAM CERAMICS

It doesn't matter if you own a chair-side CAD/CAM unit or if you send your ceramic restorations to your technician, this hands-on course will give you a good helping of ceramic restoration knowledge. More importantly, this workshop will give you tips and tricks to make your ceramic restorations last.

If you have been filled with dismay on looking at your appointment book to see a couple of ceramic onlays booked in, or if you'd like to perform ceramic restorations predictably, this is the course to do. 
