


MASTERING CAD-CAM CERAMICS

It doesn't matter if you own a chair-side CAD/CAM unit or if you send your ceramic restorations to your technician, this hands-on course will give you a good helping of ceramic restoration knowledge. More importantly, this workshop will give you tips and tricks to make your ceramic restorations last.

If you have been filled with dismay on looking at your appointment book to see a couple of ceramic onlays booked in, or if you'd like to perform ceramic restorations predictably, this is the course to do. The lectures and workshop will answer those questions that come up when you are in the 'hot seat'. Is the tooth preparation adequate and will the restoration fit? More importantly, does the ceramic restoration look good and will it last the distance? When it's time to choose a material for a clinical situation do you know when and why to choose Zirconia, e.max or Empress etc? What about the paradigm shift in resistance and retention form? And how do you predictably bond ceramic restorations to the tooth?

Understanding the intricacies of ceramics is the key to longevity, minimising failures and remakes and hence increasing your profits. The objective of the course is to focus on the key factors that will lead to a quality and long lasting ceramic restoration for your practice and your patients.
