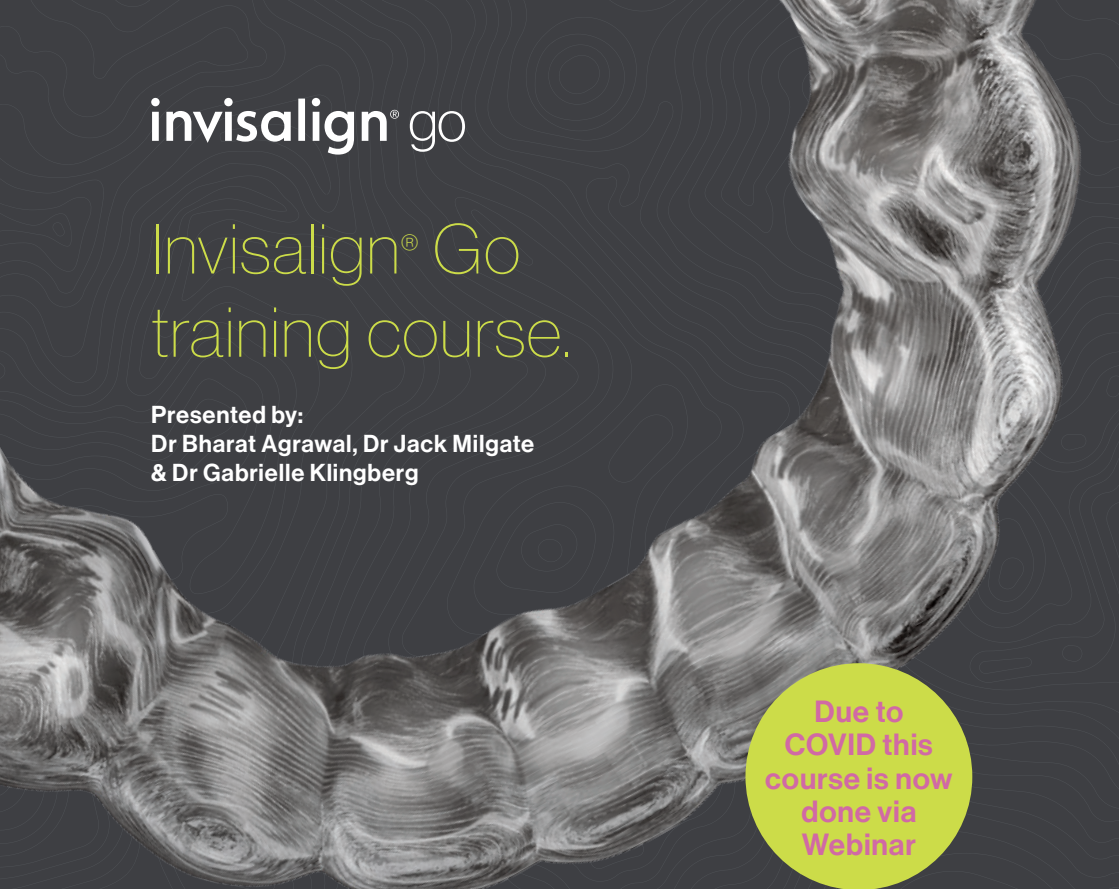

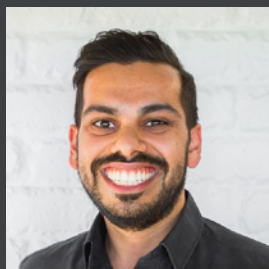

⁽¹⁾Weekly aligner changes are recommended for all Invisalign Go treatments (with default staging protocol).

The decision to prescribe weekly aligner changes is at the doctor's discretion. Monitor tooth movements such as rotations, extrusions and significant root movements. Depending on the patient response to treatment, particularly mature adults, consider longer periods between aligner changes. ⁽²⁾ Treatment times vary with Invisalign Go.

⁽³⁾Orthodontists, Paediatric Dentists and Active Invisalign Dentists are unable to register for this course.

⁽⁴⁾Attendees must be a registered General Dentist.



Dr Bharat Agrawal

Dr Bharat Agrawal has completed his Masters in Aesthetic Dentistry with Distinction (MSc AesDent) through King's College in London. His final year dissertation looked at the effectiveness and longevity of take home dentist prescribed tray bleaching techniques combined with a clinical audit.

He has presented on tooth whitening alongside minimally invasive aesthetic Dentistry in Australia and in the UK. He has had a case report selected for publication by Invisalign Australia as a clinical white paper

which looked at combination aesthetic treatments including alignment, whitening, additive bonding and dentofacial aesthetic corrections using injectables.

He has successfully utilised the Invisalign protocol and digital workflow using the iTero Elements scanner to achieve significant smile improvements without the removal of valuable hard tissue. He is actively involved in mentoring and teaching recent graduates and is passionate about the paradigm shift towards minimally invasive approaches to comprehensive smile make overs.

Dr Jack Milgate is originally from Northern Victoria – Echuca/Moama, where he grew up before moving to Bendigo to study at Latrobe University. Jack spent 2 years working and completing his Masters program in public dental health clinics throughout regional Victoria.
