**Prof. Axel Spahr**

Prof. Spahr is Head of Restorative and Reconstructive Dentistry and Periodontics as well as Deputy Head of School at The University of Sydney Dental School. He is also Head of the Department Periodontics at the Sydney Dental Hospital. He is the former Head of Periodontics at the University of Ulm in Germany and has worked at various international universities and research facilities. Prof Spahr has additional training in microbiology, molecular biology and science, animal and clinical research. His research interests include periodontal regeneration, bone regeneration, periodontitis and systemic diseases, antimicrobial therapy, dental implants and peri-implant diseases. Prof Spahr has led large externally funded research projects and is collaborating with leading international research groups and companies in the field of periodontology, implantology and bone regeneration. He has authored numerous publications in international peer-reviewed dental and medical journals, book chapters and has presented his work at professional conferences worldwide. He also works part time in a specialist periodontal and implant practice in Sydney and is the past President of the Periodontal Research Group of the International Association of Dental Research (IADR). He is a Fellow of the International Team for Implantology (ITI), the International College of Dentists (ICD), and the Pierre Fauchard Academy (PFA).



**Sahil Bareja**

Sahil is an Oral health therapist and graduated from the University of Sydney with a Bachelor of Oral Health. He further completed his Graduate Certificate in Oral Health Science from the University of Adelaide to expand his skills in adult restorative dentistry and completed his Certification in Oral Myology from Graduate School of Behavioural Sciences (USA). Sahil is currently completing his Masters in Sleep medicine from the University of Sydney.

Along with working in private practice full time in his own clinic on the South Coast, Sahil also teaches at the University of Sydney as a Clinical Educator. He is also the founder of a dental education app called Mydentalhealth, which enables patients to take responsibility of their oral health while at home unsupervised. He is also the current Director and Chair of Communications of NSW Dental Hygiene Association of Australia.
